## **Player Registration and Transfer Rules**

**Player Registration** - Players must register via the link provided by their club.

**Age Group Rules** – Players can only play in the year they were born and one year up. They cannot play down or up two years. For example, a player born in 2009 can only play in the 2009 and 2008 year groups only.

**Player Registration / Transfer Policy** - By Registering with an HKJFL club, you are committing to that club for the whole season. If the Club does not have a specific Registration process, you will be considered to be registered with that club simply by representing them in one HKJFL game. Registering in one age groups means that you are registered to that club and so you cannot then represent another club at a different age group

A player can only transfer to a different club within the current season with the written consent of the current club. The current club has every right to refuse to grant this permission and there is no right to appeal to the HKJFL.

**Date Privacy** - The HKJFL uses encryption to protect your personal data. All personal data you provide to the HKJFL are secured, and access to them is restricted to authorised personnel only and all data will be deleted after 1 year. The company used in helping collect the data on behalf of the HKJFL is a registered company in Hong Kong and will abide by the [Personal Data \(Privacy\) Ordinance](#) ([https://www.pcpd.org.hk/english/data\\_privacy\\_law/ordinance\\_at\\_a\\_Glance/ordinance.html](https://www.pcpd.org.hk/english/data_privacy_law/ordinance_at_a_Glance/ordinance.html)). This Company acts as the data service provider of the HKJFL. The Company hereby undertakes to only use the data for system design and debugging purpose. The Company will not use, or copy the data for any other purpose. All data of this service is store at secured servers of Amazon Web Services Inc (AWS). **Player Recruitment** - Coaches shall not solicit or encourage the transfer of any player currently registered to another Member Organization. Coaches shall not knowingly misrepresent the potential benefits to a player of becoming affiliated with a particular coach, team, or member organization. Coaches shall not knowingly, recklessly, or negligently misrepresent or defame programs associated with other coaches, teams, or member organizations. Coaches shall not promise or provide any compensation to a player as an inducement to register or play with a particular team or member organization. Coaches shall cease and desist from any and all recruiting activity directed toward a player upon request from the player's current club, the player themselves or the player's legal guardian.
